October 11-14, 2025



Application Requirements:

This seminar is open to currently serving police officers under 50 years of age who are members of the IPA.

Schedule:

Day 1. Saturday, October 11

Arrival At Haneda International Airport.

Registration will take place at Super Hotel Yokohama-Kannai where you'll be staying.

Day 2. Sunday, October 12

Opening ceremony at Kanagawa Prefectural Police HQRS.

The curriculum for the first day of the seminar is as follows.

Period 1: Export of Koban system from the safest country.

Period 2: Japan's Traffic Safety Measure—Importance of community participation.

Period 3: International Cooperation Activity of the Police Sector in Indonesia.

Period 4: Visit to a Koban(Police box)

Period 5: Welcome Social Gathering

Day 3. Monday, October 13

Period 1: Challenges and Prospects in Cyber Investigation.

Period 2: Japanese Koban System.

Period 3: International Cooperation of the Japanese Police.

Period 4: Japanese organized crime in South-East Asia.

Period 5: Closing ceremony and Networking event.

Day 4. Tuesday, October 14

A site visit to the Yokohama or Kamakura area is scheduled for the morning. The seminar will conclude upon completion of the visit.

Participants transitioned to their individual itineraries, such as departing for the airport.
